Seeing your baby's face for the first time is a magical moment and thanks to Preview Ultrasound, you can now do this months before the birth!

Scans in pregnancy are exciting and give us the first glimpse of the child that will dominate our lives for the next twenty years or more. Standard hospital scans gives a two dimensional snapshot that can tell us so much, but what if you could take a 4 dimensional look at your baby and take home a dvd of the moving pictures of your baby in the womb for you to marvel over time and again?

This is what Preview Ultrasound offers – a chance to see the image of your baby face to face, using a state-of-the-art scanner and software.

Local mum Claire Shields who owns Preview Ultrasound says: "It's amazing to see the clear images of the baby with the 4D scan. You can see the face really clearly and the arms, legs, fingers and toes.

"Scanning is a wonderful way of starting the bonding process and can give the parents a lot of reassurance as well."

All Preview Ultrasound's sonographers are medically qualified and there is a range of scans you can choose from.

The bonding scan is best to have at 16 weeks or later. You can find out the sex of the baby or not – if you prefer.

There are other types of scans available too: If you think you are pregnant and want to confirm this without having to wait for the your local hospital trust to call you in for a scan, you can have

this scan from a very early stage. This is particularly useful for anyone who has suffered the distress of a miscarriage in the past and wants reassurance that all is well.

As well as scanning for the pleasure of bonding and reassurance purposes, you can also have a nuchal translucency scan between 10-13 weeks that gives an individual risk factor for genetic problems including Downs Syndrome.

There is also the chance to have a scan which will confirm dates of the pregnancy and confirm whether it is a single baby or twins, or triplets. "We believe choice is very important and that is something we can offer that hospital scans do not," added Claire.

"You choose when you have your scan, where you have your scan, what type of scan and who sees the scan with you."

For many, the best part of having a Preview Ultrasound is that you can take along whoever you want to see it – your other children, grandparents, friends etc.

"It's wonderful to see the response people have to seeing their baby up close on the scan,," added Claire.

Preview Ultrasound has been operating as a mobile service for three years and has now just moved into the medical centre at Mawsely near Kettering with a fully equipped consulting room in the brand new building.

They are still offering the mobile service but that is only available for a 2D scan – similar to standard hospital scans.
